

NKS Club Principles

1. **Squad Allocation:** Upon arrival, each competitor shall draw a number from the draw container. This number determines their assigned lane and shooting squad. Consideration will be given to Juniors and Special Category (ZZ) competitors. The Organizer reserves the right to split or reassign squads in the interest of fair play or safety.
2. **Protest Fee:** A protest fee of **€5** (or the equivalent of **125 CZK**) shall be paid when submitting a protest. The competitor shall report the issue and pay the fee, after which the Referee is required to immediately inspect the target using the official gauge and follow all prescribed procedures. If the protest is found to be **unfounded**, the fee shall be retained by the Organizer. If the protest is upheld, the fee shall be refunded and the target shall either be repaired or declared void. A protest mark shall be recorded on the competitor's scorecard.
3. **Sobriety:** Any competitor found to be under the influence of alcohol or any other intoxicating substance shall be disqualified and shall bear full responsibility for any consequences arising from their actions. The Organizer reserves the right to require a breath alcohol test before and at any time during the competition.
4. **Language Assistance:** If a foreign competitor is unable to communicate in Czech, German, or English, they shall be provided with a marshal assistance card, which may be used to request the assistance of a Marshal.

These principles are intended to ensure the highest possible level of fair play throughout the competition.
